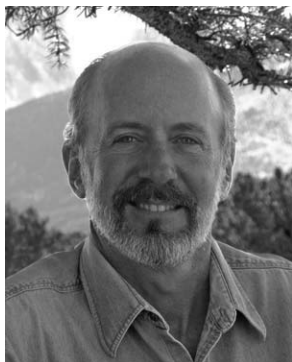
In addition, they have learned the fundamentals of brokerage and other areas of real estate specialization.
